WISH GRANTING VOLUNTEERS Wish granters work with our wish children to help them determine their most heartfelt wish. Wish granters then work with the staff to help make these wishes come true! Time commitment varies, but is approximately 10 hours per month based on granting 3 wishes per year. This includes traveling to wish family homes, wish planning and implementation. Wish Granters must have strong communication skills, and be able to respond to wish families and staff within 48 hours.
